 - a. 100% profit realized by Grade 3

Notes: Grade 3 students will set the prices.

Grade 3 is responsible for storage and disposal of all unsold books. If Grade 3 wishes to donate these books to the end of year Used Book Sale, books will need to be packed into boxes, secured, labeled with "Used Book Sale" on the sides of the boxes, and delivered to the Lower School Library.

In all cases, Grade 3 students will be responsible for inventory, bookkeeping, accounting, and financial reporting once the bookshop closes. Grade 3 students will be responsible for their own cash box(es). Grade 3 students will also need to spend a little time with Miss Betty to get tips on selling the new books.
